Trash & Recycling Basics

Trash & recycling calendar included with this guide



TRASH: Collected every week on Monday. Use your red cart.

Lid must be completely closed.

Contact Board of Health to purchase overflow bags



RECYCLING: Collected every other week on Monday. Use your blue cart.

NO plastic bags or flexible packaging
NO scrap metal/wood or styrofoam
NO napkins, paper towels or PPE
NO cartons (milk, juice, broth)



MATTRESSES: Schedule curbside pickup for a fee through UTEC at utecinc.org/mattress-recycling/

RAIN BARRELS: Each Spring discounted rain barrels are available (contact Conservation Director)

SMALL SCRAP METAL: Recycle at Highway Department
