trash bag.**

Disposal of collected items

When you have filled up a yellow trash bag, tie it up and leave it by the side of the road or next to your curbside trash. The Highway Department and Republic Services will collect bags.
Note that your bag might be left out for a few days to help remind your neighbors that April is town-wide clean-up month.
