TRASH is collected **every Monday**.

- Use only Town issued RED trash toter.
- Trash bags left beside cart will not be collected unless accompanied by an overflow trash bag sticker.
- Trash cover must be completely closed.



RECYCLING is collected **every other Monday**.

- Single stream recycling: all recyclables go in the BLUE toter.
- See the calendar and street listings below for your pick-up week.



WHAT TO DO WITH ITEMS THAT CANNOT BE PLACED IN YOUR TRASH OR RECYCLING:

Department of Public Works (DPW) - 89 Kendall Rd; Middle School - 50 Norris Rd; Elementary School - 205 Westford Rd

ELECTRONICS AND APPLIANCES - Bring to Zero Waste Day (see below) or call Republic Services at 978-649-7564.

BULKY ITEMS AND OVERFLOW TRASH BAGS- Bulky item stickers (\$15) and overflow trash stickers (\$5) can be purchased at the Board of Health Office or [ONLINE](#) (sticker(s) will be mailed to you).

FURNITURE - If broken/unusable, purchase bulky item sticker. If in good condition, donate to The Wish Project ([thewishproject.org](#)), Household Goods in Acton ([householdgoods.org](#)), or bring to Zero Waste Day (see below).

TEXTILES - Schedule free curbside pickup ([helpsy.co/pickup](#)), bring to a collection bin at the Recycling Center at the DPW or the satellite parking lot of the Middle School, or bring to Zero Waste Day (see below).

MATTRESSES AND BOX SPRINGS - Schedule curbside pickup for a fee through UTEC at [utecinc.org/mattress-recycling](#) or 978-856-3997, OR donate if no stains, rips or tears at Zero Waste Day or by contacting The Wish Project in Lowell ([thewishproject.org](#)) or Household Goods in Acton ([householdgoods.org](#)).

LARGE OR EXTRA CARDBOARD - Flatten and bring to container in satellite parking lot of the Middle School or the Recycling Center at DPW.

SHARPS/NEEDLES - Drop off at Board of Health Office (must be in puncture-proof and shatter-proof containers such as sharp containers or plastic detergent or bleach containers).

MEDICATION (EXPIRED/UNWANTED) - Pills can be drop off in a kiosk at the Police Station. Remove all information and place in a zipped bag. Liquid medicine – contact Police Dept or Board of Health for a drug deactivation bag.

YARD WASTE – Drop off at site located near Town Hall, off Bryants Lane. Open April (1st Tues) to December (2nd Sat.) Residents can also purchase compost bins (\$35) at the Board of Health Office for backyard composting.

CHRISTMAS TREES - Drop off in January at the DPW or the parking lot at 180 Lakeview Ave (no bags or decorations).

HAZARDOUS WASTE - Any item labeled hazardous, flammable, poisonous, corrosive or explosive, plus tires and more. Bring to **Household Hazardous Waste Day (HHW)** – 8/9/2025 from 9:00-12:30 at the DPW. See website for other HHW dates and locations.

SOLUTIONS AND EVENTS TO FURTHER REDUCE YOUR TRASH AND RECYCLING

RECYCLING CENTER @ DPW - Cardboard, Scrap Metal (No AC unit), Food Waste, Textiles, Mercury-Containing Items (Fl. Lightbulbs, thermometers, etc.).

ZERO WASTE DAY – Normally held on 1st Saturday of May and November, from 9am-12pm at the Elementary School. All items collected will be put to reuse or recycled. Please visit the Sustainability Committee's website for more info.

FOOD WASTE COMPOSTING - Bring all food scraps to the Recycling Center at DPW or subscribe to curbside collection by contacting Black Earth ([www.blackearthcompost.com](#)).
